

## **ASSISTANCE IN FORFEITURE PROCEEDINGS**

- The Requested Party shall, subject to its domestic laws, endeavor to locate, trace, restrain, freeze, seize, forfeit or confiscate property derived from the commission of an offence and instrumentalities of crime for which such assistance can be given provided that the Requesting Party provides all information which the Requested Party considers necessary.
- Where a request is made under paragraph 1, the request shall be accompanied by the original signed order, or a duly authenticated copy of it.
- A request for assistance under this Article shall be made only in respect of orders and judgements that are made after the coming into force of this Treaty.
- Subject to the domestic laws of the Requested Party, property forfeited or confiscated pursuant to this Article may accrue to the Requesting Party unless otherwise agreed in each particular case.
- The Requested Party shall, subject to its domestic laws, pursuant to any agreement with the Requesting Party transfer to the Requesting Party the agreed share of the property recovered under this Article subject to the payment of costs and expenses incurred by the Requested Party in enforcing the forfeiture order
